Global top ten leaders in industry for sustainability in health

Prince of Wales International Business Leaders Forum - GSK were showcased for their exemplary practices for Resilience Programs and were the Global Top Ten leaders in industry for sustainability in health, March 2006.

Gold H.E.A.L.T.H award

Quality Road, Singapore received the Singapore HEALTH (Helping Employees Achieve Life-Time Health) Award. This award is presented by the Health Promotion Board to give national recognition to organisations with commendable Workplace Health Promotion (WHP) programmes.

Good practice award

The European Agency for Safety and Health at Work for “Young Employees - Safe Start in GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals SA” was awarded to the Poznan Site. This good practice includes health initiatives undertaken at this site for all employees.

The excellence through people standard

Awarded to GSK Dungarvan by Ireland's National Training and Employment Agency. It is a human resource standard and the only one of its kind in Ireland. The standard identifies a level to which a company must work across - from recruitment to performance management to health and well being.

Excellence in best practices in occupational safety & health award

Presented to GSK Pakistan by the Employers' Federation of Pakistan (EFP). GSK was the only pharmaceutical company to receive this award.

Innovative excellence award

Given to GSK for the Team Resilience Program. As the highest honour, the Work-Life innovative Excellence Award was created in 1996 to showcase programs and policies that demonstrate excellence in enhancing and promoting work-life effectiveness while achieving organizational goals.

Best employers for healthy lifestyle gold award
