2010 Times Top 100 Graduate Employers

The Times Top 100 list is produced annually by The Times and High Fliers Publications. It is based on face-to-face interviews with more than 16,000 graduates who left UK universities in the summer of 2010. The students are asked which employer they think offers the best opportunities for graduates, and the students are only allowed to give one response. GSK has consistently been one of the top 20 Graduate Employers for the last six years and was ranked 14th in the UK 2010 Times Top 100 Graduate Employers List, and ranked 15th in 2009.

Britain's Most Admired Companies Award 2009

GSK has been ranked fifth in Britain's Most Admired Companies 2009 by Management Today – Britain's leading business magazine. 236 British companies were ranked in the most admired league table for 2009. In conjunction with Birmingham City Business School, Management Today asked Britain's largest public companies in 25 sectors to evaluate their peers, as well as analysts at leading investment companies. These scores combine to give the overall position of the companies in each category. GSK also came first in two other special categories: Ability to attract, develop and retain top talent & Financial soundness And second in two more special categories: Quality and management & Quality of marketing These are Britain's longest running and most respected business awards. They are considered the 'Oscars' of the business world, and have become a benchmark for excellence.

The students are asked which employer they think offers the best graduate opportunities and the students are only allowed to give one response. GSK has consistently been one of the top 20 Graduate Employers for the last four years and was ranked 14th in the UK 2008 Times Top 100 Graduate Employers List.

2008 Employer of Choice for Research & Development

GSK has been voted The 2008 Times Employer of Choice for Research and Development for the fourth year running. The two runners up were again NHS and AstraZeneca. This result was gathered from the survey from those students who had or were applying for positions within the R&D Career Sector. They were asked to name two employers they would most like to work for. Out of a list of 150 companies developed by 1677 students GSK was mentioned most frequently.
